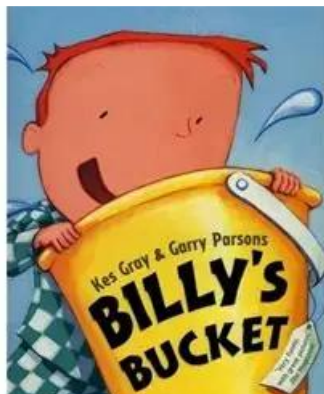


Early Years' Class News

In Science, we have started to think about all the different animals we know.

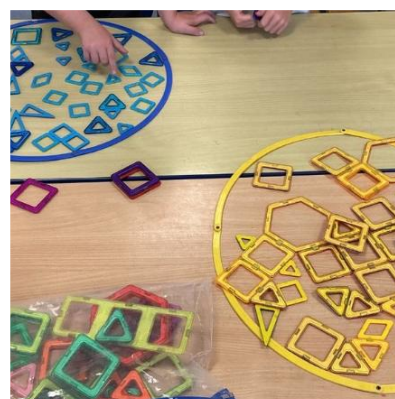
Listening to poems about different sea animals.

We have begun to learn French in Year 3 as well! We have started to learn some French phonics and have even learnt how to say some animals in French.

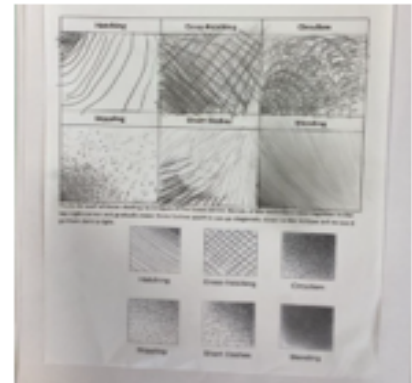
The Year 3's have also been practising different shading techniques ready to start creating artwork inspired by Adonna Khare.
